We are pleased to offer our Fall 2019 Catalog, with a variety of fun and exciting classes for the children of PS116. Our diverse selection of recreational classes focuses on playtime, downtime and enrichment that will spark imagination and creativity in your children.

# To Register:

- Online registration begins Monday, September 9th, at 12pm. Please visit our website, www.116kids.org/register, for instructions (click to download 'Registration FAQs'). If you would like to pay by credit or debit card, please set up an online account and register at www.116kids.org. Visa, MasterCard and American Express are accepted. If you are a returning family, please be sure to update your student profile with classroom #s for the 2019-20 school year!
- Paper registration forms and payment may be left in the 116Kids mailbox in the Main Office starting Tuesday morning, September 10th. Paper forms will NOT be accepted before that date. If you would like to pay by cash or check, or would like to apply for a scholarship, please use a paper registration form. Checks should be made payable to "PTA of PS116." Please indicate a second-choice class on paper forms. Your child will be enrolled in the class of your choice unless the class is full. If so, a 116Kids representative will contact you. Paper forms submitted without payment will not be processed until payment is received.

- All outstanding balances must be addressed before you can enroll for the new Fall Session.

## 116Kids Basics:

- Each session is 10 weeks. After-school classes do not meet on half-days or holidays. Please see calendar below for dates.
- While some classes will have up to 20 students with 2 instructors, all classes will maintain a ratio of no more than 10 students to 1 teacher.
- Class Change Policy: You may switch your child to another available class **ONE TIME** without a fee. There is a fee of \$25.00 for each additional class change. Class admission is based on availability at the time of change.
- We reserve the right to cancel classes with insufficient enrollment. If a class is cancelled due to low enrollment, we will be happy to place your child in an alternative class without charge or refund your tuition.
- 116Kids After-School Enrichment is a not-for-profit corporation run by the PTA of PS116.

**116Kids strives to maintain an environment where children feel safe.** Please review these guidelines with your child so they may enjoy our after-school program. All children should:

- o show respect for others, their space and their property, as well as the space and property of the classrooms in which we hold our classes,
- cooperate with 116Kids supervisors and instructors,
- o remain at their designated table during snack and while waiting for 116Kids instructors to take them to class, remain with their instructors during classes and until a parent/guardian signs them out at pick-up.

Unacceptable behaviors include: using profanity, disrespecting others and their space, failure to comply with directions, excessive horseplay, and inappropriate or violent physical contact. 116Kids may report incidents of unacceptable behavior to the parents/guardians of all children involved. If your child becomes disruptive or does something dangerous, it will result in a suspension of the child's next class. If the behavior continues, it could lead up to dismissal from 116Kids. 116Kids reserves the right to remove a child from the program for unacceptable behavior.

## Pick-up & Dismissal:

- Classroom teachers will dismiss kindergarten & 1st grade children enrolled in our program directly to 116Kids staff at the end of the school day. 2nd-5th grade students head directly to the cafeteria from their classroom. Please make sure that your child knows their schedule.
- Children enrolled in 116Kids are supervised before and after their classes by our highly competent 116Kids supervisors, who ensure your children are safe and comfortable. A snack is provided to all children before 116Kids classes begin. Typical snacks include apple slices, carrot sticks or string cheese. You are welcome to send snacks to school with your children.
- Dismissal for 116Kids is at 5:00pm in the cafeteria.
- There is a supervised Extended Hour, from 5:00pm-6:00pm, for an additional \$100 per 10-week session. You must pay for all 10 weeks; please add \$100 to your registration payment.
- Dismissal time is strictly enforced. Students with regular dismissal time (5:00pm) will join our Extended Hour if a parent/caregiver has not yet arrived by 5:10pm, and a \$15 drop-in fee will be charged. There is a \$20 fee for late pick-up between 6:01-6:15pm. The Late Fee increases to \$40 for late pick-up between 6:16-6:30pm. After 6:30pm, the Late Fee increases to \$50. Subsequent late pick-ups will result in expulsion from our program. Please avoid these fees by always picking up your child on time.
- If you need to pick up your child early, you must notify 116Kids in advance. Parents will not be permitted to go to the 116Kids room; a staffer will bring your child to you. No early pick-ups can be accommodated before 3:15pm or after 4:45pm.
- To ensure the safety of your child, please make sure that all Emergency Contact and Authorizations
  for Pick Up are up-to-date in your account. We do not have access to Blue Emergency Contact
  Cards in the Main Office.
- You will be required to sign for your child at pick-up each week.
- Please let us know of any absences.

## Payment and Scholarships:

- The cost for each class is \$215 per 10-week session, plus a \$25 registration fee and any supply fees.
- All children enrolled in 5 classes per week will receive a \$150 discount. The discount will be
  automatically deducted when registering online. Please deduct the appropriate amount on the
  registration card if using a paper form. Classes run by outside vendors DO NOT qualify for our
  discounts.
- If your family meets the federal guidelines for free lunch, we offer financial aid for one class per child per session. Please indicate on the registration form that you are applying for financial aid and attach a copy of your meal-status eligibility letter to the form. The \$25 registration fee, supply fees and Extended Hour are not covered by financial aid. These fees are due with the registration form. Classes run by outside vendors may not be eligible for financial aid.
- Discounts/financial aid cannot be combined. One discount or financial aid per student per session.
